- 1) Meeting Minutes 11/21/22 approval – Judge Powers moves to approve Judge Williams seconded the motions. Minutes are approved.
- 2) Membership – Welcome new members Ryan Rodighiero, Justin Rock
- 3) Treatment court / BHC support letters. Arron Grigg moves to issue letters of support to specialty courts. Judge Williams seconded the motion. Issuance of support letters is approved.
- 4) Pretrial – Overriding circumstances regarding pending cases, standard is 2 or more.

Pretrial Services are intended to be a resource to assist a defendant with barriers to making it to court. Supplying information regarding bus/transportation, food, and supplies, as well as housing. Release officer has been meeting with law enforcement agencies to introduce themselves and the program improvements.

Judge Powers - time to disposition is a big target and it is important to make sure defendants are not on pretrial release for extended periods of time waiting for resolutions of their cases. Pretrial services will be monitoring that as well as other court functions. This may lead to shortened time from arraignment to plea or other measure intended to streamline the process beginning at the time a defendant is arraigned.
