BE IT REMEMBERED, that at a regular term of the County Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Union, sitting for the transaction of county business, begun and held at the Court House in the City of La Grande, in said County and State, on Wednesday, the 5th day of August, A. D., 1957, the same being the first Wednesday of said month and the time fixed by law for holding a regular term of said Court, when were present:

WHEN, on Thursday, the 8th day of August, A. D., 1957, or the second Judicial day of said term, among others, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the vacation of a portion of County Road No. 278, and all of County Road No. 585.

At this time, the above entitled matter comes on for hearing upon the report of the County Engineer on the proposed vacation of a portion of County Road No. 278, and all of County Road No. 585, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

County Road No. 278: Commencing at a point on the West right-of-way line of the O. W. R. and N, Railroad (Union Pacific System) near the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 7, Tp. 5 S, R 40 E. W. M., Union County, Oregon; thence running westerly and northerly a distance of approximately five and three-quarters (5 $\frac{3}{4}$) miles to a point on the Ladd Canyon road running from La Grande to North Powder, Oregon, approximately one-eighth mile West of the center of Section 5, Tp. 5 South, Range 39, E. W. M.

County Road No. 585: Commencing at the northwest corner of the south half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 3, Tp. 5 South, Range 39, E. W. M.; thence in an easterly direction one thousand nine hundred twenty-six (1926) feet.

And it appearing to the court from said report that the portion of County Road No. 278 proposed to be vacated, and all of County Road No. 585 are no longer useful as a part of the general road system of Union County and is burdensome to maintain; and it further appearing from the affidavit of posting on file, that the County Engineer more than 30 days prior to August 8, 1957, the date set for the hearing of the Engineer's Report, did post three notices of the hearing in the vicinity of that portion of County Road No. 278, proposed to be vacated, and also in the vicinity of County Road No. 585, and also posted one notice at the place of holding County Court; and that said notices remained posted at least 30 days before the date set for the hearing; and it further appearing that no person has appeared to object to, or remonstrate against the proposed vacation.

It is therefore, CONSIDERED and ORDERED that the portions of said roads above described be, and the same are hereby vacated.
