BE IT REMEMBERED, that at a regular term of the County Court of the State of Oregon, for the County of Union, sitting for the transaction of county business, begun and held at the Court House in the City of La Grande, in said County and State, on Wednesday, the 4th day of May A. D., 1964, the same being the first Wednesday of said month and the time fixed by law for holding a regular term of said Court, when were present:

WHEN, on Thursday, the 7th day of May, A. D., 1964 or the 2nd Judicial day of said term, among others, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the vacation of portions of County Roads No 233 and 429.

ORDER

WHEREAS, it appears to the County Court of Union County, Oregon, that a portion of County Road No 233 and a portion of County Road No 429, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter (SW cor of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 40 East., Willamette Meridian, at point A 1 of county road No 233 running thence north to A2 of said road, thence on county road No 429 to A 1, thereof, thence to A 2, A 3, A 4, A 5, A 6, A 7, A 8, A 9, A 10 and A 11, thence northeasterly approximately one-fourth mile to the terminus of said county road No 429,

and is useless as a part of the general road system of Union County and has not been used by the public as a part of the general road system of Union County; and would therefor now be burdensome to maintain.

WHEREAS, said portions of said roads No 233 and No 429 are no longer in use by the public, and the public will be benefited by the vacation of said portions of said roads;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that such proceedings as are required by law generally, and ORS 368.565 et. seq. specifically, to vacate said described portions of said roads will be undertaken.
