



WHEN, on Wednesday, the 7th day of May, A. D., 1964, or the 2nd Judicial day of said term, among others, the following proceedings were had, to-wit:

In the matter of the vacation of portions of County Roads #233 and 429.

The County Court of Union County having adopted a resolution on this the 7th day of May, 1964, declaring its intention to vacate portions of County Roads #233 and #429, which runs through and over the following described parcel of land: Commencing at the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (SW cor of NW 1/4 NE 1/4) of Section 8, Township 4 South, Range 40, East., Willamette Meridian, at point A1 of County road No 233 running thence north to A2 of said road, thence on County road No 429 to A1, thereof, thence to A 2, A 3, A 4, A 5, A 6, a 7, A 8, A 9, A 10, and A 11, thence northeasterly approximately one-fourth mile to the terminus of said county road no 429.

It is therefore ORDERED that the County Roadmaster be directed to view that portion of County roads No 233 and No 429 to be vacated, and to file his recommendation with the court on or before ~~xxxxxx~~ July 2nd, 1964.
