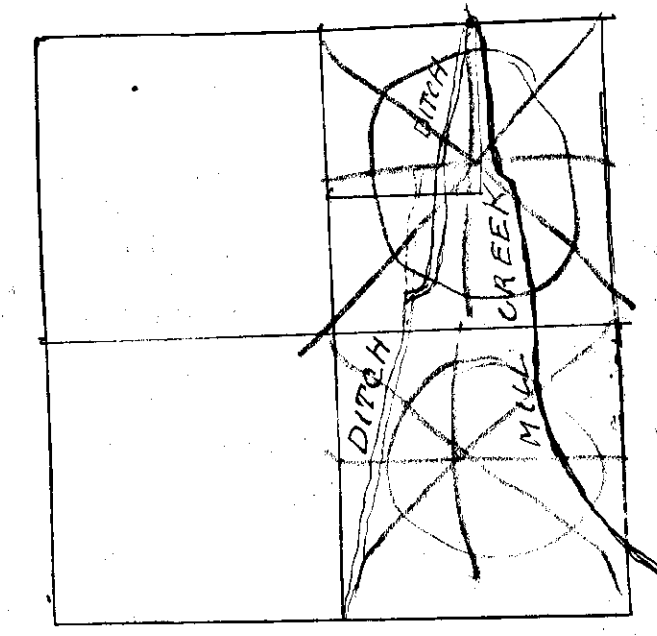


-APPROPRIATION OF WATER-
 -POINT OF DIVERSION-
 -LOCATION NOTICE-

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN-that the Mill Creek Water Co-a private corporation has on this 30th day of October 1906 appropriated from the waters of Mill Creek for irrigation, domestic, household and power purposes-one thousand (1000) cubic inches of water by Miners' inches measurement under a six inch pressure-said water to be diverted in, by and through a ditch, flume, canal or aqueduct-the head gate of which is proposed to be constructed, point of appropriation and diversion, is upon the west bank of said Mill Creek-at this point and location, within a few feet of the northeast corner of the northwest qr of the northeast qr of Section 2 in Township 1 south of Range 38 E.W.M. and in said qr of Sec.-and in Union County, Oregon;-that the Name of said Ditch or Canal or Flume is The Mill Creek Water Co's Canal-that its owner is The Mill Creek Water Company-a private corporation;-said Ditch, Flume or Canal is to be constructed and maintained six (6) feet wide at the bottom and ten (10) feet wide at top and to be three (3) feet deep; and to be located and running in the most practicable route in a southeasterly direction from said point of diversion and location to the southwest corner of the southeast qr of Sec. 2 in Twp 1 south of Range 38 E.W.M.-and to have two (2) reservoirs on the last named quarter section of land for storage purposes.
