COME NOW the undersigned, a majority of the freeholders resigning in the district in which the road is located, and petition the County Court of Union County to vacate County Road Number 69, also known as Ramo Flats Road, as hereinafter described. Attached to this Petition is a map of County Road Number 69 which shows the land owned by each Petitioner within the Road District, and the termini of the road proposed to be vacated.

That portion of County Road Number 69, as more particularly described hereafter, is useless as a part of the general road system of Union County. It is burdensome to maintain and the public will be benefited by its vacation.

County Road Number 69 traverses part of Sections 30,31, and 32 of Township 4 South, Range 40, and parts of Section 4,5,8,9,16, and 17 of Township 5 South, Range 40, E.W.M., Union County, Oregon. The portion of said road which the undersigned requests be vacated see page 3.

The undersigned request the County Court to notify the County Surveyor or County Roadmaster of Union County and by Order direct one of such officers to examine the road and make a report in writing on the road. It is requested that the Surveyor or Roadmaster include in his report his opinion as to whether the road should be vacated, whether the road is or has been in use, and whether it will be advisable to preserve the road for a general road system in the future, or whether the public will be benefited by the vacation, together with any other facts, matters or things which may be of importance to the County Court.

It is further requested that after the report by either the County Surveyor or the County Roadmaster has been completed that it be filed with the County Clerk and that the County Court then fix a date for hearing the report required by ORS 368.570, and cause notice of such hearing to be given at least 30 days before the date set for the hearing in accordance with ORS 368.575.





On June 30, 1981, the County court did vote to vacate that portion of Ramo Flats County Road No. 69 from the cattle guard at the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 9, Twonship 4 South, Rang4 40 East of the Willamette Meridean, extending approximately one and one-quarter (1.25) miles south, then westerly about one (1) mile to its intersection with Oregon Highway No. 237, as the same appears on the attached Exhibit #1. Then, on July 8, 1981, the County Court did vote to amend the vacation of the described portion of Ramo Flats County Road to provide for access to Tax Lot 3300 of Section 17, Township 5 South, Range 40 East of the Willamette Meridian, from Oregon Highway No. 237 across the former Ramo Flats roadway via an exclusive roadway easement provided by the landowners of Tax Lot 800, of Township 5 South, Range 40 East of the Willamette Meridian, to the State of Oregon Dapartment of Transportation and their sddigns.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The County Court finds that the landowners of Tax Lot 3300, of Section 17, Township 5 South, Range 40 East of the Willamette Meridian, State of Oregon Department of Transportation, would not have roadway access if said portion of Ramo Flats County Road is vacated to the adjacent landowner without the allocation of an exclusive easement.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Court Order #80-149 be amended to provide for an exclusive roadway easement across the formerly designated Ramo Flats County Road from Oregon Highway No. 237 to Tax Lot 3300, of Section 17, Township 5 South, Range 40 East of the Willamette Meridian, from the landowner 9s0 of Tax Lot 800 of Township 5 South, Range 40 East of the Willamette Meridian, to the landowner (s) and their assigns of Tax Lot 3300 for ingress and egress.
