All persons interested in or concerned with that portion of the county road used and traveled for more than forty-nine (49) years commencing at a point 143.24 feet southeast of the northeast corner of Section 19 of Township 2 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Union County, running thence 1.47 miles from the north end of Owsley Canyon Road to the south end of Section B of Mt. Emily County Road, and termination at a point 245 feet west of the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 18, Township 2 South Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian are hereby notified that the road has been resurveyed, and the County Court will, on October 21, 1981, at 9:30 A.M., in the Union County Courthouse Annex Conference Room, hear and determine whether the road herein described and included in the survey shall be ordered as a lawful county road and public highway; and objections thereto, or claims for damages, must be filed in the office of the County Clerk of this county on or before October 14, 1981, or the road hereinabove described will be declared a county road and public highway.

On this day this matter come on for hearing and the Court in session pursuant to ORS 368.585 through ORS 368.610 did consider the matter of the legalizing the Mount Emily Road, Section "A" as a County Road, beginning at a point 143.24 feet southeast of the northeast corner of Section 19 of Township 2 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Union County, running thence 1.47 miles from the north end of Owsley Canyon Road to the south end of Section "B" of Mount Emily County Road, and terminating at a point 245 feet west of the southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 18, Township 2 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian, as the same appears on the attached Exhibit #1 (map) and #2 (filed legal description).

Findings of Fact

The County Court finds that as a result of extensive research in the County Clerk's and County Roadmaster's records and filed the field notes of the original survey and the Court action designating Section "A" of Mount Emily Road a County Road and developed a legal description which is attached as Exhibit #2.

The Court further finds the Union County Surveyor has reserved Section "A" of Mount Emily Road as a County Road has been posted in three public places in the vicinity of the road and one additional notice posted at the Union County Courthouse.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Section "A" of Mount Emily Road Beginning at a point 143,24 feet southeast of the northeast corner of Section 19 of Township 2 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Union County, running thence 1.47 miles for the north end of Owsley Canyon Road to the South end of Section "B" of Mount Emily County Road, and terminating at a point 245 feet west of the southeast corner of the southwest corner of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 18, Township 2 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian, is legalized as a County Road and recognized as a part of the County Road System.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED the County Court will entertain a petition to reduce the livestock district in the vicinity of Section "A" of the Mount Emily Road and if any road widening activity is initiated necessitating timber removal, the timber will be delivered to local Grnade Ronde Vally lumber mill of Mr. Donald Shaw's choice; payment for the slae of timber to be remitted to mr. Donald Shaw.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED the September 2, 1981, survey of the Mount Emily Road, Exhibit #2, be recorded with County Clerk.
