In the matter of Purchasing
a strip of land from T.G.
Wilson for County Road purposes }

This matter came on to be heard at this time on the Proposition of T.G. Wilson to sell to the County for County Road purposes a strip of land as follows: Commencing at a point 1220 feet North and 30 feet East of the SW corner of NW^{1/4} Sec 28 Township 45 R 40 E W M running thence 108 $\frac{1}{3}$ feet in a northeasterly direction to a point 80 rods North and 60 feet east of the said SW corner of NW^{1/4} of said Sec 28, thence North 40 rods thence 108 $\frac{1}{3}$ feet in a northwesterly direction to a point 560 feet South and 30 feet east of NW corner of said Sec 28 in said Township and Range thence South 860 feet more or less to the place of beginning and it appearing to the Court that said proposition is fair and reasonable, that it would be to the best interest of the County to purchase said lands, that the said T.G. Wilson offers to deed said strip of land to the County for Road purposes for the sum of \$50⁰⁰ in County Warrants the said described piece of parcel of land to revert to the said T.G. Wilson or his assignee in case the County Road is ever vacated. It is therefore considered and ordered that the proposition of the said T.G. Wilson be accepted and the Clerk of this Court is hereby authorized and instructed to draw a warrant on the General Fund for \$50⁰⁰ in favor of the said T.G. Wilson when he shall have properly dedicated the said described parcel of lands to the public or deeded the same to Union County Oregon for the purposes above set out.

In the matter of the
Petition of Nels Hobson }
for Liquor License }

This matter came on to be heard at this time on the Petition of Nels Hobson for a license to sell spirituous malt and vinous liquors in less quantities than one gallon in Delgard precinct for the period of six months from the 5th day of June 1895 and it appearing to the Court that said petition is signed by an actual majority of all the legal voters residing in said precinct, that said petition has been published for four consecutive weeks as by law required proof of which has been filed herein, that said Nels Hobson has paid into the County Treasury the sum of \$200⁰⁰ and filed his receipt therefor with the Clerk of this Court that he has filed a good and sufficient bond herein in
