In the matter of the petition of the La Grande Investment Company, a corporation, for the vacation of Alicel Orchard Tracts, excepting Tracts 18 and 19 thereof.

Now at this time this matter comes on to be heard upon the petition of the La Grande Investment Company, by its President, W.B. Sargent, for the vacation of the plat and survey of Alicel Orchard Tracts, excepting tracts 18 and 19 thereof.

And it appearing to the Court that the said La Grande Investment Company is the owner in fee of all the lands embraced in said Alicel Orchard Tracts, excepting Tracts 18 and 19 thereof and that from the plat or map filed herewith, showing the vacation of the said portions of Alicel Orchard Tracts, that the public is not inconvenienced in any rights or privileges by the vacation of said plat as asked for; that the survey or plat sought to be vacated is not embraced within the boundaries of any unincorporated town, and the court being fully advised in the premises,

It is hereby ORDERED that the petition of said La Grande Investment Company is hereby granted, and that all of said Alicel Orchard Tracts as originally platted and surveyed, excepting as to Tracts 18 and 19 thereof, be and the same are hereby vacated.

Thereupon it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned until tomorrow, November 8th, 1917, at 9 o'clock A.M.
