It is CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said deed be accepted and the County Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the General Road Fund of the County in the sum of \$225.00 in favor of Mary J. Rogers in payment therefor.

In the matter of the purchase of lands to be used as a gravel pit at North Powder, Oregon.

Now at this time it appearing to the court that Thomas Brasher acting for and on behalf of the court has secured an option from Mrs. Nettie Titus for the purchase of Block 25, in the town of North Powder, Union County, Oregon, for the sum of \$1700.00, and it further appearing that it is necessary that Union County acquire the above described property for use as a gravel pit from which to secure gravel for the improvement of the county road in the vicinity of North Powder,

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that this Court does hereby agree to purchase said property at and for the sum of \$1700.00 upon the delivery by the said Nettie Titus to Union County of a good and sufficient warranty deed to said property and an abstract of title to date.

In the matter of the acceptance of the deed of G. I. Wade to lands to be used as a section of the Ladd Canyon Road.

Now at this time is presented to the court the deed of George I. Wade and Mary S. Wade his wife, to a strip of land 60 feet in width commencing at the confluence of Ladd Creek and the East branch of Ladd Creek at what is known as the old Linebarger place in Section ______ Township 4, S. R. 38 E.W.M., and running thence Southeasterly along the east branch of Ladd Creek through the South half of Section 14, and the East half of Section 23, in Township 4, S. R. 38 E.W.M. to a point where the old county road crosses said east branch of Ladd Creek Easterly and Westerly at what is known as the Engel place, and it appearing that it is necessary and convenient that Union County acquire the land above described for county road purposes.

It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that said deed be accepted and thatUnion County does hereby agree as a consideration for said deed to erect a good and lawful fence on or before April 1st, 1921 along the east and west side of said strip of land and to install two watering troughs and pipe water thereto, one trough to be located on the point of the hill on the East side of said road and immediately north of what is known as the old Beeswax bridge, the other trough to be located on the East side of said road at or near the South end of the land described in the deed above referred to.
