It is therefore CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise said warrants for cancellation in the manner provided by law.

In the matter of the petition of Everett Walker to Vacate Parts of L Street in East Addition to La Grande, Oregon.

Now therefore upon the nomination and request of Ben Grout, and his mother, his father being dead, the court hereby appoints Bert Grout as guardian ad litem of Ben Grout, a minor, in this proceedings.

In the matter of the petition of Everett Walker to vacate parts of L Street in East Add. to La Grande, Oregon.

Now at this time this matter came on for hearing and it appearing to the court that all persons having land and real estate on either side of the part of street to be vacated or adjacent to said part of street have filed their consent in writing, duly acknowledged to the vacation of said part of street. That three duplicate copies of the notice on file with the proof of posting in this proceeding were posted in three public places within East Addition to La Grande, Oregon, and in the vicinity of the part of street to be vacated, as specified in said notice, one at each end of the part of street to be vacated, and posted on a post facing outward so as to be plainly seen and one on the public road within said East addition, and about two hundred feet from the part of street to be vacated, on a post facing outward so as to be plainly seen. And the Court finds that the ^{said} places of posting were public places within East Addition to La Grande and in the vicinity of the part of street to be vacated. That the said notices were posted on the 2nd day of May and remained posted up to the 6th day of June, 1928; that said copies of notices were in the words and figures of the copy attached to the proof of posting in this proceedings, and gave notice that the undersigned Everett Walker had petitioned the

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the county court of the state of Oregon for Union County to vacate that part of L Street lying and being between Wall Street and East Street in East Addition to La Grande, Oregon, and that any one desiring to objection to the vacation of the said part of street should present the same to the county court of Union County, Ore., on or before the beginning of said June term 1928 when the prayer of said petition would be passed upon by said court. And the Court finds that East Addition is a platted acreage of the city of La Grande, Oregon, outside of the corporate limits of said town. That L. Street has been platted and dedicated more than ten years prior to the filing of the petition in this proceedings but has never been open to public travel, and has never been traveled by the public. That no objections have been made to the vacation of the said part of street.

It is therefore ORDERED that that part of L Street lying and being between Wall Street, and East Street in East Addition to La Grande, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated, and it is so ordered.

Thereupon it was ORDERED that Court be now adjourned for the term, the journal of todays proceedings having been read, approved, and which is here now signed.
