On April 24, 1967 the Board of County Road Viewers herein filed a report, based upon the petition of Harley McDonald and Lottie McDonald and the Order of this Court, and on May 10, 1967 an amendment to said report by said road viewers was made and entered herein, changing the assessment of damages from \$20 to \$120. Photocopies of the original reports herein referred to are attached to this Order and by this reference made a part hereof.

It appears to the County Court that the report of viewers and the amendment hereto are just, with the exceptions hereafternoted, and that the petitioners have paid into this court the cost of the viewers and the damages assessed on May 11, 1956; that the petitions should be required to fence and maintain the fence on both sides of the roadway provided for in these proceedings and that said roadway should be considered a public road; Now, Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY CONSIDERED AND ORDERED that, with the exception hereafter noted, the reports of the board of county road viewers above referred to be and the same are hereby confirmed, and a public road 30 feet wide is hereby established along the following line and in the following location:

The northern boundary line thereof shall be the north line of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 29, Township 1 North Range 39 EWM: it shall commence at the edge of the Hug-McDonald county road at the west end of the aboute quarter section line and then shall run east along that line approximately 1100 feet to a natural drainage depression; from this point it shall proceed in a southeasterly direction, following said natural depression for a distance of approximately 200 feet to a natural opening in the timber, and from such opening it shall proceed approximately 100 feet northeast to a point 30 feet south of the southwest property corner of Harley and Lottie McDonald at the southwest corner of the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 29, said township and range.

REPORT OF BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD VIEWERS

TO THE HONORABLE COUNTY COURT FOR UNION COUNTY, OREGON:

The undersigned Board of County Road Viewers, heretofore on the 24th day of April 1967, did meet as instructed at 10:00 a.m. on April 24th, 1967, to lay out and alter a proposed public road petitioned for by Harley and Lottie McDonald for access to their property located in the east half of the northeast quarter of Section 29, and the west half of the northwest quarter of Section 28, all Twp 1 North, Range 39 EWM, and our findings are as follows:

- 1.
