The report shall include the opinion of the surveyor (roadmaster) as to whether the road should be vacated, whether the road is or has been in use as a part of the County road's system during the past 25 years, whether it will be advisable to preserve the road as a part of the general road system in the future or whether the public will be benefited by the vacation of said County road, and all other facts, matters and things which are of importance to the County Court.

Upon completion of the report it shall be filed with the County Clerk.

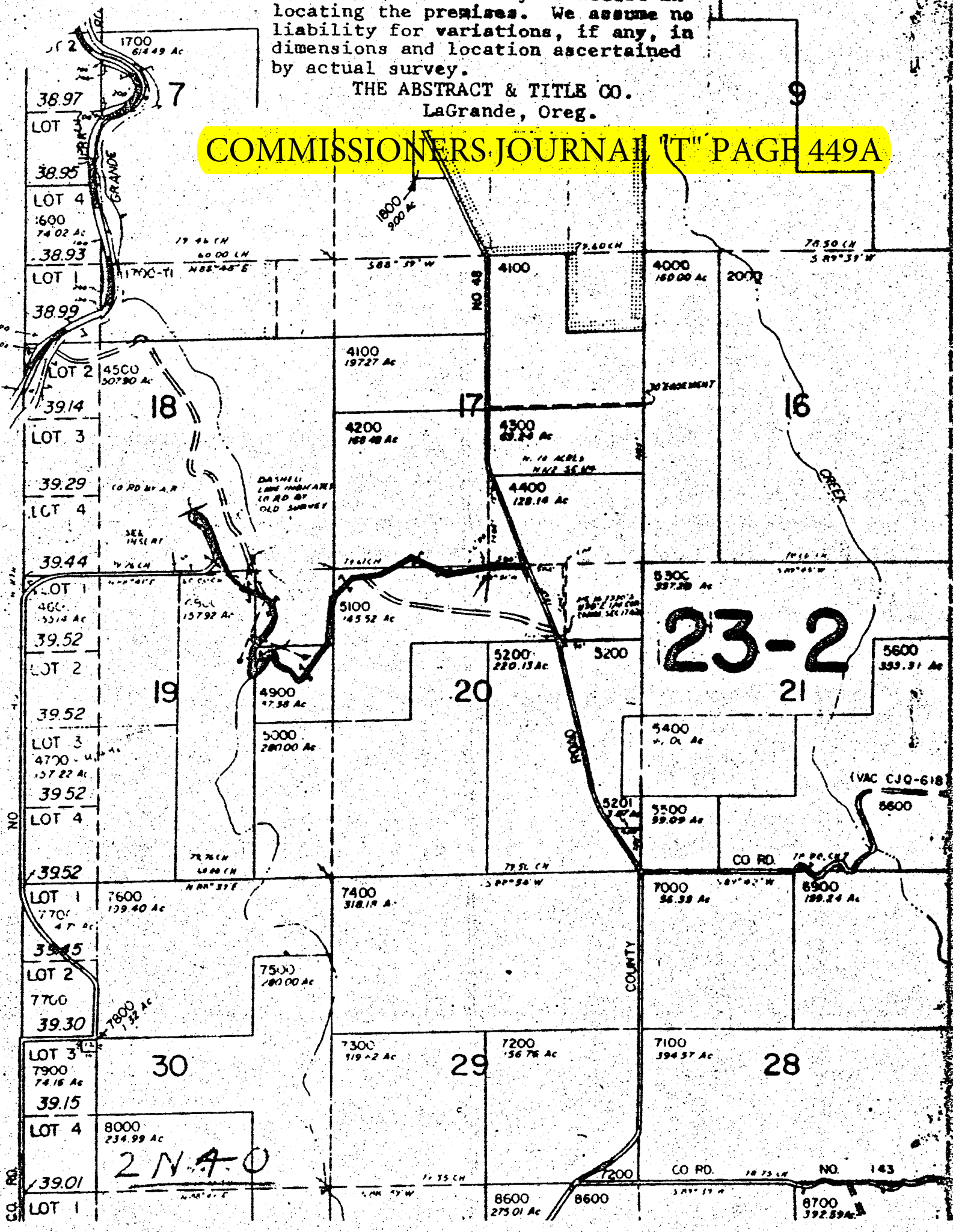

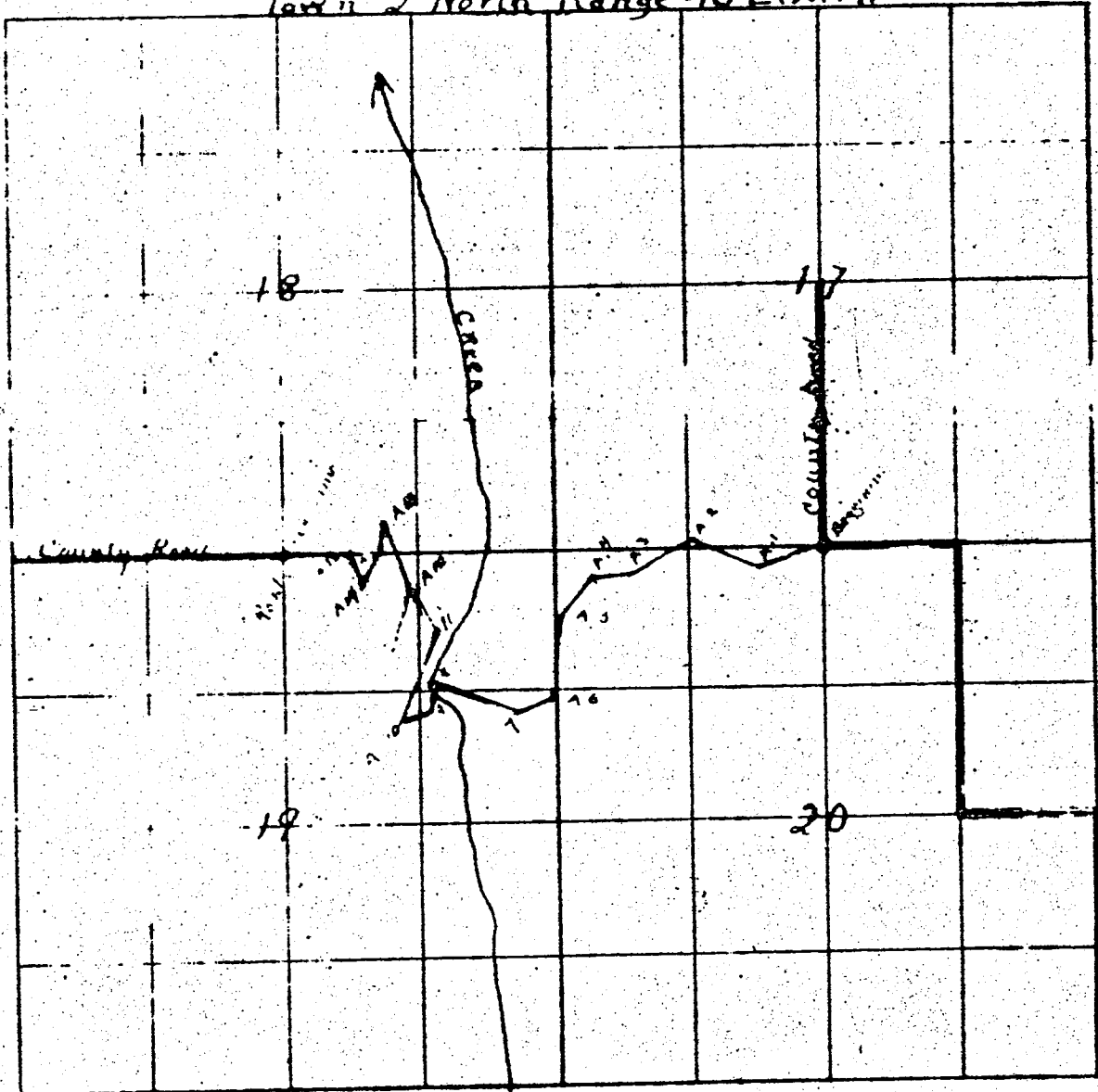

FINDINGS OF FACT
