A PORTION OF CHANDLER-LEFFEL ROAD

On this day this matter came on for hearing and the Court in session pursuant to ORS 368.570 and ORS 368.580 did consider the matter of the vacation of the north end of the Chandler-Leffel County Road beginning on the south side of the property described below and running north to the termini, as the same appears on the attached Exhibit "A". Description of property: The northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section 28, in Township 2 south, Range 38 East of Willamette Meridian, situated in the County of Union, State of Oregon, as the same appears on the road maps of Union County, State of Oregon.

FINDING OF FACTS

The County Court finds that the said County Road is burdensome to maintain, it is not needed as a part of the County Road System, and has not been used as a part of said County Road System for many years.

The Court further finds that no person or persons residing on the County Road and depending thereon for access will be adversely effected by its closure.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the portion of the Chandler-Leffel County Road, heretofore described be vacated pursuant to the map attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A".

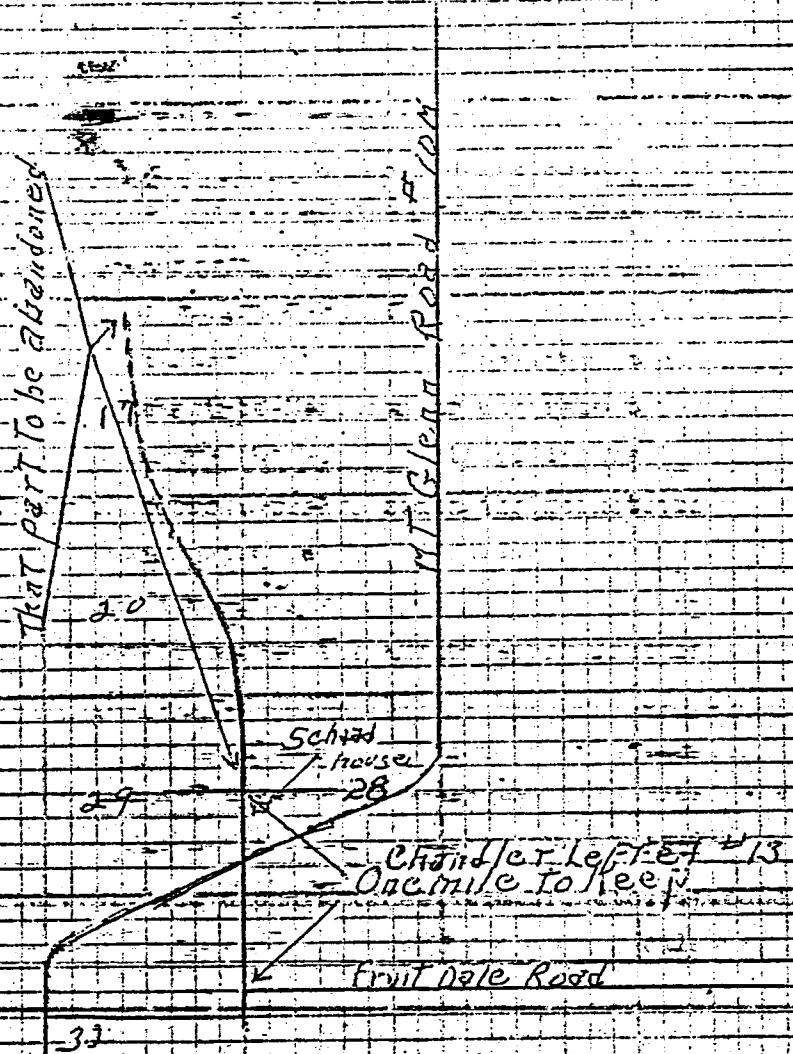
