A PORTION OR ROULET-HARDY ROAD)

ORDER OF ROAD VACATION

On this day this matter came on for hearing and the Court in session pursuant to ORS 368.570 and ORS 368.580 did consider the matter of the vacation of that portion of Roulet-Hardy County Road Number 46 (original number 480), more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 30 feet East of the Corner Common to Sections 19 and 30 T2N., R.40 EWM. and Sections 24 and 25 T2N., R. 39 EWM. thence East 1290 feet to Point A5 (referred to in original notes of County Road Number 480), as the same appears on the attached Exhibit A.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The County Court finds that the said portion of Roulet-Hardy County Road (abandoned) is burdensome to maintain, is not needed as a part of the County road system, and has not been used as a part of said County road system since 1930 when a portion of said road was vacated by the Union County Court.

The Court further finds that no person or persons residing on the County road and depending thereon for access will be adversely affected by its closure.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the portion of Roulet-Hardy County Road Number 46 (abandoned) herein above described be vacated pursuant to the map attached hereto and marked Exhibit A.

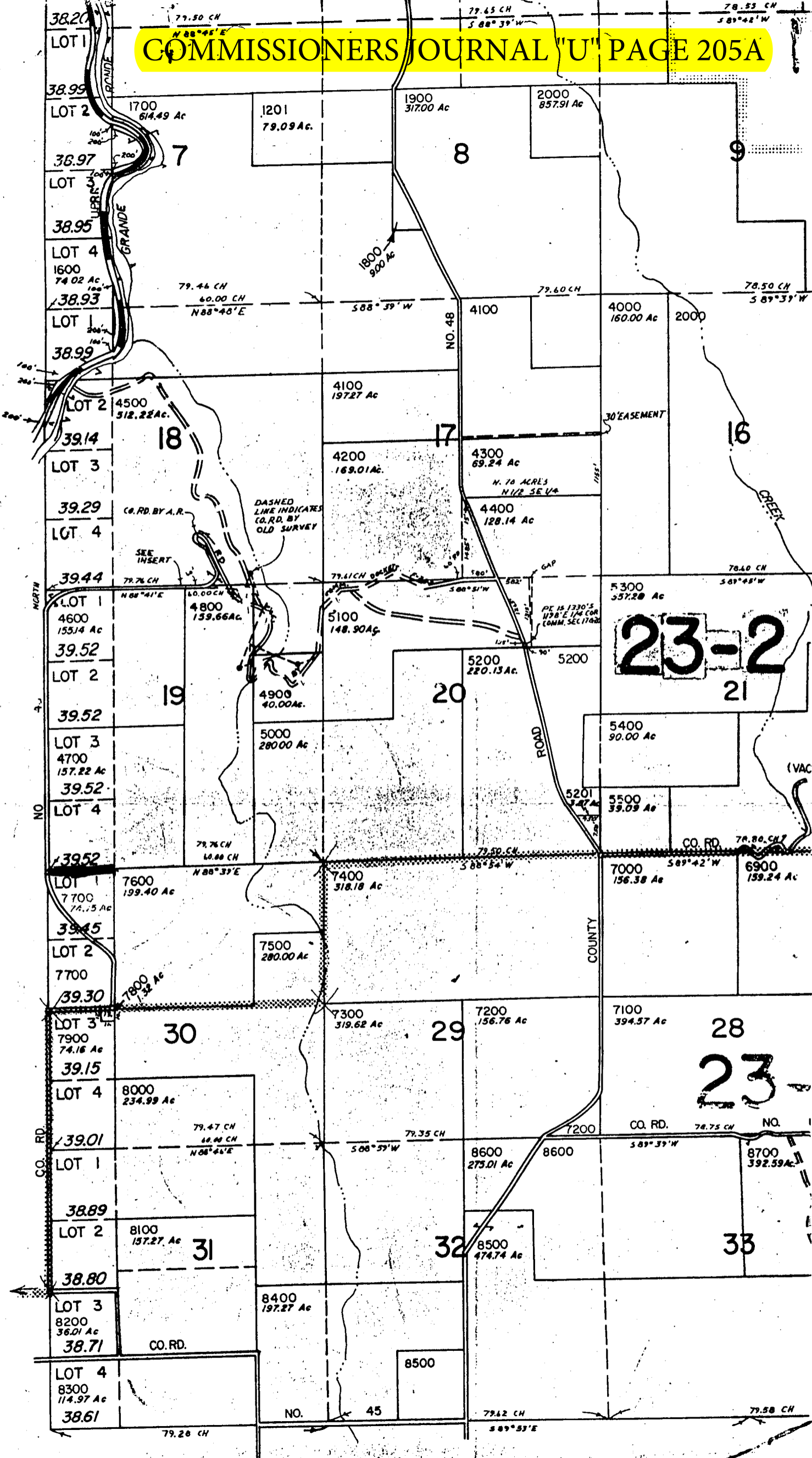
