The County Court further finds that no person or persons residing on the County Road and depending thereon for access will be adversely affected by its closure, and no adverse comment was made during the hearing of June 18, 1980 set by the County Court.

ORDER:

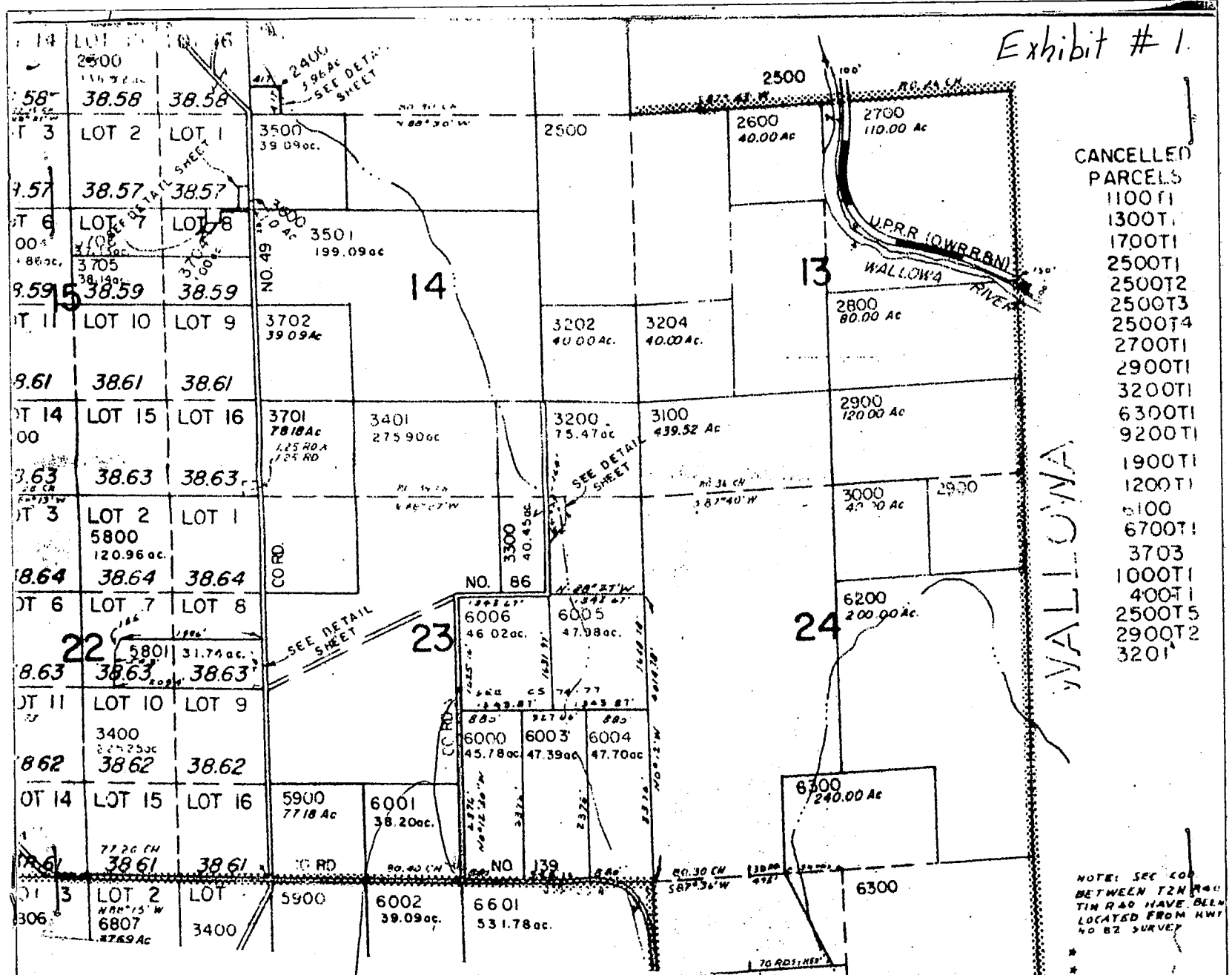

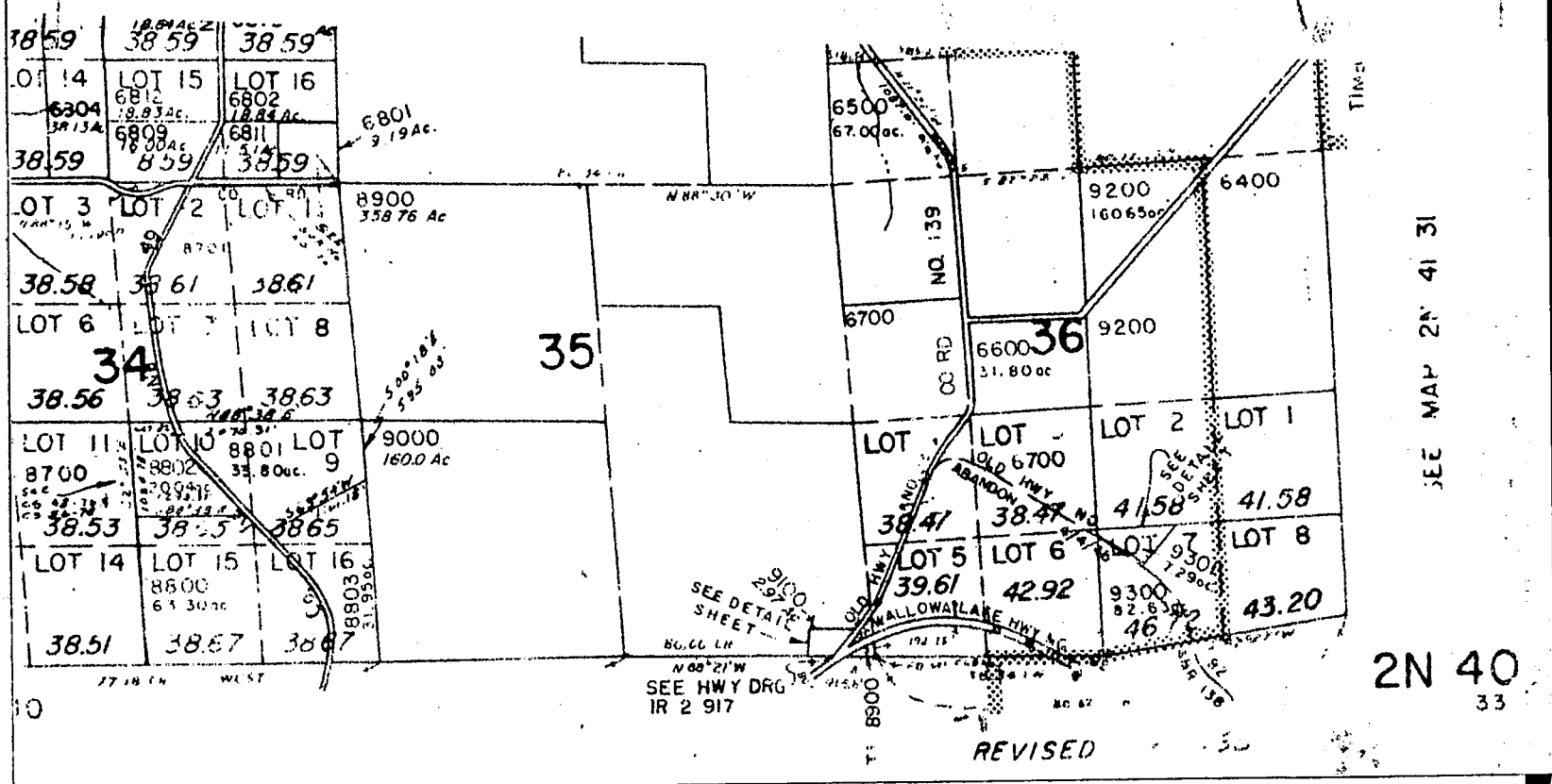
