It is my understanding that if a corner position is used to determine other corner locations then that corner must be set to reduce the prospect of confusion or variation in future surveys. The deed for this parce! of land was described as beginning 15 feet west of the east one—sixteenth corner between Sections 4 and 9, and the sixteenth line seems to be the La Grande city limits. This creates a small strip of land attached to a larger parcel of land that may cause city administrators a problem in the future. The survey of this parcel does not require a section

The deed used cardinal directions on all four courses, so the side lines were made perpendicular to the section line. Also there is no mention of Cove Avenue in the deed and I could not find any record of acquisition by or dedication to the public for this road. There is a mention in the narrative of Survey No. 26—88 that the centerline of Cove Avenue and the section line is not common, but contains no further explanation.
