# NARRATIVE

This survey was ordered by John Collins on behalf of Marie Warnstaff. Survey number 033-1995 subdivides the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, and this Partition is based entirely on Survey Number 033-1995. The Warnstaff Parcel "is comprised of 2 legal descriptions One description begins "at a point 40 rods East of the Southwest corner of the Northwest I/4 of Section 34, Township 2 South, Range 38 East of the Willamette Meridian, running thence East 20 rods, thence North 40 rods, thence West 20 rods, thence South 40 rods to the place of beginning." The second description begins at a point 20 rods East of the Southwest corner of the Northwest I/4 of Section 34, thence East 20 rods, thence North 40 rods, thence West 20 rods, thence South 40 rods. It is my professional opinion that these descriptions were written assuming the Section to be a perfect 5280 feet square. I believe that the people Intended to divide on the north line of the South I/2 of the Southwest I/4 of the Northwest I/4. A neat section would have divided out I320 x I320 in this I/4, I/4, however there is I326.I3 feet per I/4, which is an excess of 3.06 feet instead of a neat 660 feet. It is my opinion that the intent of the deeds was to divide the North and South half equally in the SW I/4 of the NW I/4. I believe that is also true for the East and West break. I have therefore platted to the North line of the South I/2 of said SW I/4, of said NW I/4. I also divide the description equally east and west using the intent to be equal argument. I find no other problems with this survey.
