Beginning at a point which bears North 64°01'33" West, a distance of 882.77 feet, from the South quarter corner of said Section 34, said point being the Southeast corner of Parcel 2 of Minor Partition Plat Number 1999-13, said point also being on the West line of a road easement identified as Microfilm Number 31946 in the records of Union County,

Thence; South 0°04'28" West, along said West line, a distance of 116.30 feet, to the Northerly right of way line of First Street (Wallowa Lake Highway),

Thence; North 89°30'56" West, along said right of way line, a distance of 109.16 feet,

Thence; North 0'57'28" East, a distance of 132.77 feet, to a point that is 8.5 feet distant Northerly, when measured at right angles, from the centerline of an existing spur track of the Union Pacific Railroad Company,

Thence; North 89°47'46" West, along a line parallel with said centerline of said spur track, a distance of 22.89 feet,
