
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Index File No. A-3

History of original corner establishment:

Record of the original survey by Jacob C. Cooper, Contract No. 397, 1881, \underline{states} :

Set post, 3 1/2 ft. long, 3 ins. square, 1 1/2 ft. in the ground, marked 1/4 S on N and S faces, for 1/4 sec. cor. on east hillside, 15 ft. above dry branch in heavy timber, from which:



A Tamarack 26 ins. diam. bears N2°W 10 lks. dist. marked $1/4\ S\ BT$,

A Fir, 12 ins. diam. bears S32°E 43 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

No trace remains of the original corner post. We establish the <u>True Corner Point</u> in the following relationship to the original bearing trees:

An orig. 26" Tamarack, now down and badly rotted, with scribing "1/4 S BT" visible on an unhealed double blaze, bears $N2^\circ W$ 6.6 ft.,

And an orig. 12" Fir, now a 34" Grand Fir, alive and in good condition, no markings visible, bears S27°E 28.3 ft.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the <u>True Corner Point</u>, we set a 2"x30" Galvanized Iron Pipe, 27" in the ground on a slight East hillside, with brass cap attached, marked:

T2N

From which we mark new BT's:

R S31 1 38 + 4 E S6

A 12" Grand Fir, scribed "1/4 S31 BT" on a double blaze bears N 82 1/2°W 15.6 ft., and a 10" Douglas Fir, scribed "1/4 S6 BT" on a double blaze bears S29°W 17.1 ft.

T1N PLS1099 1980

Attached brass washer stamped "LS 1099" to lower blaze of new BT's.

Placed steel fencepost 5 ft. East of monument with signs 54-2 and 54-4 attached.

Attached signs and painted BT's per <u>Standard Specifications for Cadastral Survey</u>, U.S.F.S. Region 6, Oct. 1979.

Compass Declination: 20°E
