History of original corner establishment:

Set post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. sq., 2 ft. in ground,
marked T 2 N, S 33° on the N.E., R 38 E, S 4° on the S.E.,
T 1 N, S 5° on the S.W., and S 32° on the N.W. with
4 notches on the East and 2 notches on the West, from
which;

A Fir 12" Ø bears S 30° W, 10 Lks. marked T 1 N, R 38 E, S 5 BT
A Fir 8" Ø bears S 49° E, 25 Lks. marked T 1 N, R 38 E, S 4 BT
A Fir 12" Ø bears N 58° E, 9 Lks. marked T 1 N, R 38 E, S 33 BT
A Fir 14" Ø bears N 27° W, 14 Lks. marked T 1 N, R 38 E, S 32 BT

Description of corner evidence found:





Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the
original location of this corner:

At the position described above, I set a 2½" x 30" iron pipe
26" in the ground with a Brass Cap, marked as shown, from
which I scribe BT's;

A Spruce 11" Ø bears S 17° E, 19.20 ft., marked T 1 N, R 38 S 4 BT
A Spruce 14" Ø bears S 34° W, 43.70 ft., marked T 1 N, R 38 S 5 BT
A Spruce 14" Ø bears N 41° W, 72.10 ft., marked T 2 N, R 38 S 32 BT
A Spruce 18" Ø bears N 85° E, 32.80 ft., marked T 2 N, R 38 S 33 BT

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.
I set a steel fence post 5 ft. North with signs 54-4.
I painted a red band around BT's and face of scribe.
I used a steel tape and magnetic compass with 19° East variation and
measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BT's.
This corner was set 8/5/80, witness by Patrick Murphy.
