Description of corner evidence founds

Fir 25" N 82 $^{\circ}$ E, 25.70 ft., good condition, Blazes closed (GLO Fir 12" N 70 $^{\circ}$ E, 39 Lks,)

Fir 8" S 50° W, 15 Lks, Found dead and down with usable scribing.


Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner.

At the position described above, I set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" iron pipe 20" in the ground with a Brass Cap, marked as shown from which I scribe BT's.

Fir 14" S 22^{0} W, 26,50 ft., scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ s BT Painted blazes and placed BT and Attn. sign and red band on above found BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes. I set a steel fence post 5 ft. North with signs 54-4.

I painted a red band around BT's and face of scribe. I used a steel tape and compass with 19° declination and measured a horizontal distance to the center of the BT's. This corner was set 8/13/80, witness by Patrick Murphy. See map of survey.
