

An 8" Douglas Fir bears North 39° East a dist. of 27.60 ft., marked E 1/16 S36 BT. A 23" White Fir bears South 15° West a dist. of 13.55 ft., marked E 1/16 S1 BT.



A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
