A fir 19" in diam. bears N 45^o24' W 146.9' scribed CN 1/16 S3 BT.

I nailed a brass washer marked OPLS 1097 to BT blazes.

I set a steel fence post 5' West and 5' South with signs 54-2 and 54-4.

I painted a red band around BTs and face of scribe.

I used a steel tape and Wild T16 and measured a horizontal distance center of the BTs.
