Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" iron pipe 18" in ground and raised a 2' mound of stone around the pipe with a brass cap marked as shown.

From which I scribed BTs:

A pine 20.2" in diam. N 14° W 26.7' scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT. A pine 22.5" in diam. N 38° E 16.1' scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

I nailed BT posters and attention signs to BTs.

I nailed a brass washer marked PLS 1097 to BT blaze on both trees.

I set a steel post 2 North with an attention sign.

I set a poster 1,300' West on Phillips Creek Road.

I used a staff compass with $21^{\rm o}$ declination and a steel chain measuring distances horizontally.

I painted a red band and scribed blazes of BTs .
