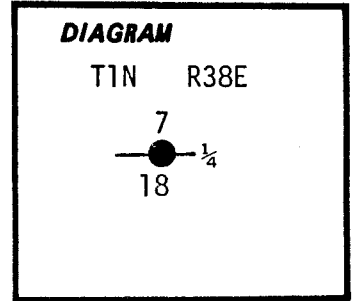


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:
Record of the original survey by J. Kimbrell,
1891, states:

$\frac{1}{4}$ 7/18

- A Fir, 3" diam. which I mark $\frac{1}{4}$ S on N face for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., from which:
- A Fir, 3" diam. bears N20°W 7 lks dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.
- A Fir, 5" diam. bears S7°W 32 lks dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

Description of corner evidence found: No trace remains of the original corner or accessories.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: Corner set from survey at location determined by single proportionate measurement.

At the corner point, we set a 2"x30" galvanized iron pipe, 26" in the ground, with brass cap attached, marked:

From which we mark new BT's:

A 22" Larch, scribed " $\frac{1}{4}$ S 7 BT" on a double blaze bears N73°W 84.8 ft.

And a 20" White Fir, scribed " $\frac{1}{4}$ S 18 BT" on a double blaze bears S53 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W 52.3 ft.

Attached brass washers stamped "LS 1099" to lower blaze of new BT's.

Placed steel fencepost 5 ft. East of monument with sign 54-9 attached.

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

John W. Kimbrell, 1891, Contract 579

Set: A fir, 3 ins. dia., marked 1/4 S on N face, from which:

- A fir 5 ins. dia. bears S 7° W 32 lks. (21.1 ft.) dist. marked 1/4 S BT
- A fir 3 ins. dia. bears N 20° W 7 lks. (4.6 ft.) dist. marked 1/4 S BT

Langlitz, PLS 1099, 1980, CS 97-80

Found: No trace remains of the original corner or accessories.

Set: At a point determined by single proportionate measurement a 2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe, 26" in the ground, with brass cap, from which:

- A 20" white fir, scribed "1/4 S 18 BT" on a double blaze bears S 53 1/2° W 52.3 feet
 - A 22" larch, scribed "1/4 S 7 BT" on a double blaze bears N 73° W 84.8 feet
- Attached brass washers stamped "LS 1099" to lower blaze of new BTs

Description of corner evidence found:

Monument Found:

A 2 1/2" brasscap, marked as shown, on a 2 1/2" galvanized iron pipe, in good condition, and 4" showing above the ground. Guard post with LSM East 5.2 ft.

Accessories Found:

A white fir, (record 20 in. diam.) alive/healthy, bears S 53 1/2° W, 52.3 ft., with healed double blaze. (Langlitz BT)

A tamarack, (record 22 in. diam.) dead & standing, bears N 73° W, 84.8 ft., partial scribing visible on a double blaze. (Langlitz BT)

Note: Looked for original corner and its accessories. Found no remains of the original corner or original BTs.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Accessories Set:

A white fir, 4 ins. diam, bears N 25 1/4° E 38.5 ft. marked X BT on a double blaze with a brass washer stamped PLS 2456.

A white fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S 25 1/4° E 14.7 ft., marked X BT on a double blaze with a brass washer stamped PLS 2456.

A white fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N 68 3/4° W 55.4 ft., marked 1/4 S7 BT on a single blaze with a brass washer stamped PLS 2456.

Red paint, posts and signs added as needed.

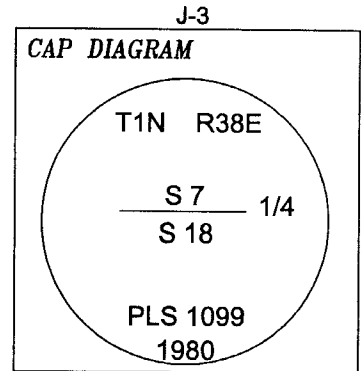
