# Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the location of this corner.

At position determined by survey, I set a 2 ins. diam. aluminum cap, on a 5/8 ins. diam. x 30 ins long iron rod, 8 inches below road surface, marked as shown.

From which:

A ponderosa pine, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 55° E., 24.3 ft. dist., marked "XBT" on a double blaze. A ponderosa pine, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 40° W., 30.4 ft. dist., marked "XBT" on a single blaze. Corner position falls on East edge of pit run road surface.

Bearings are made with a hand compass, magnetic declination = 14°E.
