

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO MONUMENT THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position by survey I set a 2 $\mbox{1/2}" \times 30"$ aluminum pipe, 15" in the ground, in a mound of stone 3' with 3" aluminum cap marked as shown below, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 5/8"x18" iron pin bears North 45° East a dist. of 40.00 ft., with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked NE RP.

A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears South 45° East a dist. of 31.00 ft., with 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked SE RP.

A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears South 45° West a dist. of 45.00 ft., with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked SW RP.

A 5/8"x30" iron pin bears North 45° West a dist. of 10.00 ft., with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked NW RP.

Set steel fence post approx. 1' West.

West/South fence corner bears North West of monument approx. 180 ft..
