

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 27" in the ground, from which::

#### NEW BEARING TREES:

A 7" White Fir bears North 35° East a dist. of 9.75 ft., marked "W1/16 S17  $\rm PT"$ "

A 7" White Fir bears South 5° East a dist. of 8.40 ft., marked "W1/16 S20 BT".

Set a steel post approximately 1 ft. north of the monument.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 13° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the bearing trees. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
