





A 2" aluminum cap on a 5/8" x 30" rebar, stamped as shown below, was set at this corner location.

A $5/8" \times 30"$ rebar with yellow plastic cap inscribed "APA" bears N90°E, 10.0 feet.

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with yellow plastic cap inscribed "APA" bears N30°W, 10.0 feet.


