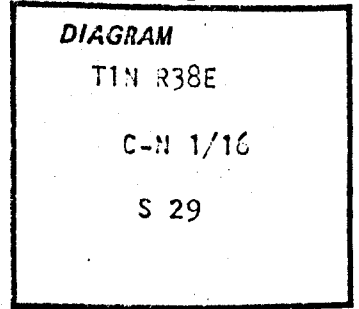


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

No record of subsequent monumentation found in County Records.

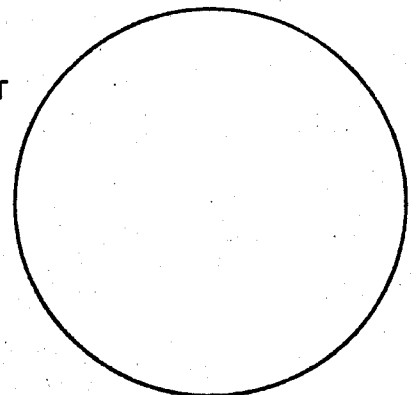
Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At proportionate distance I set 5/8" x 30" iron pin with plastic cap marked "BGA Survey Marker", from which:

- A 14" fir bears S 40° W, 52.5 ft marked CN 1/16 S29 BT
- A 9" tamarack bears S 78° E, 25.9 ft marked CN 1/16 S29 BT
