

At a position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with a 2 ½" aluminum cap marked as shown 28" in the ground. From which:

A 6" Ponderosa Pine bears S 52° W, a distance of 40.65 feet, marked CN 1/16 S28 BT. A 6" Ponderosa Pine bears N 59° W, a distance of 37.80 feet, marked CN 1/16 S28 BT.

Set a steel fencepost +/- 0.5 foot South of corner monument.

I used 16° East declination, the distances are to a 60d spike driven into the right side of the root crown of the new bearing tree. A brass washer marked OPLS 83571 is attached to the BT blaze of the new bearing trees.
