

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

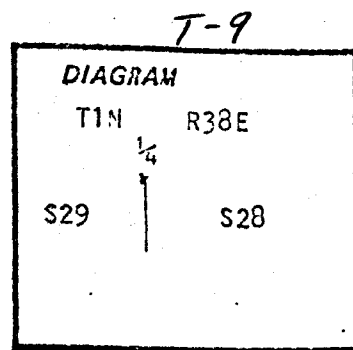
History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Joseph G. Gray under GLO contract No. 120 dated May 27, 1867.

Surveyor General Record states

Set 1/4 section corner post from which:
A fir 10" diameter bears S 40° E 54 links
A pine 18" diameter bears S 88° W 64 links

Retraced by Kimbrell in 1891 who set stone 18" x 10" x 8" in place of rotted post

None.

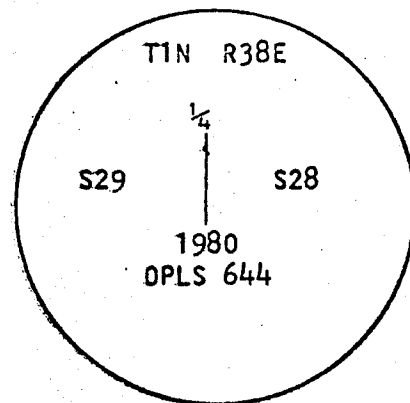

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At proportionate distance I set 1 1/2" x 30" iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown 28" in ground.

Raised mound of stone.

No trees available
Steel fence post 3+ ft W



Brass washer nailed to BT blaze. Used steel tape and magnetic compass with 17°E declination. Distance measured to center of tree.
