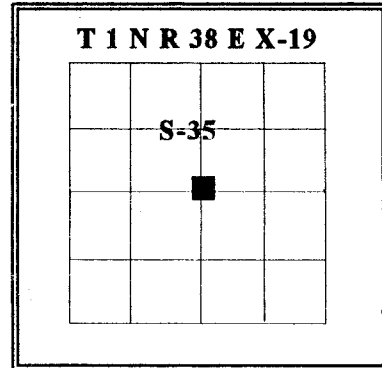


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

This corner was not established in the original survey.

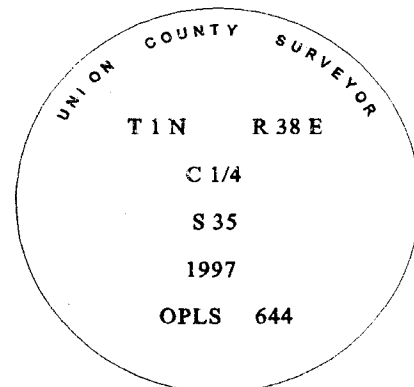
DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At a position determined by survey, I set 2-1/2 inch by 30 inch aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 36 inches in the ground, 6 inches below ground level.

From which, new B Os;

- A 5/8" by 30" rebar bears N 46° E, 8.88 feet, with 1-1/2" aluminum cap marked "UCS NE RP".
- A 5/8" by 30" rebar bears S 38° E, 26.84 feet, with 1-1/2" aluminum cap marked "UCS SE RP".
- A 5/8" by 30" rebar bears S 28° W, 25.00 feet, with 1-1/2" aluminum cap marked "UCS SW RP".
- A 5/8" by 30" rebar bears N 68° W, 8.40 feet, with 1-1/2" aluminum cap marked "UCS NW RP".

Position is in a cultivated field 30± feet south of an east - west fence line.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 18° east declination and the measurement was taken to the center of the aluminum cap on the rebar.
