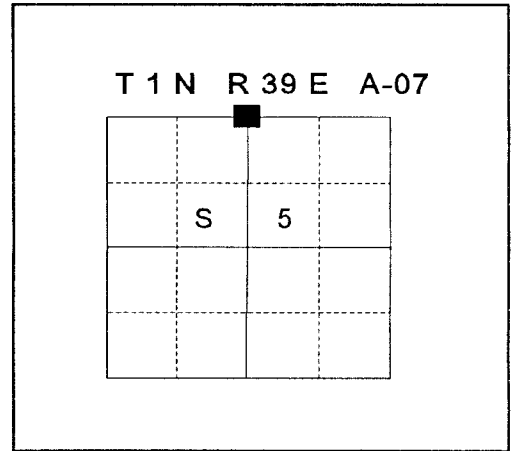


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by Timothy W. Davenport under GLO contract no. 102, dated July 20, 1863. Surveyor General record states:

Set qr sec post from which:
A tamarack 18 in dia bears S25°E, 27 lks.
A tamarack 6 in dia bears N50°W 20 lks.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in UNION COUNTY survey records.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument or its accessories.

Proportionate position falls in an old down North-South fence, approximately 15 feet North of an existing East-West fence.

See Survey Number 032-1997.

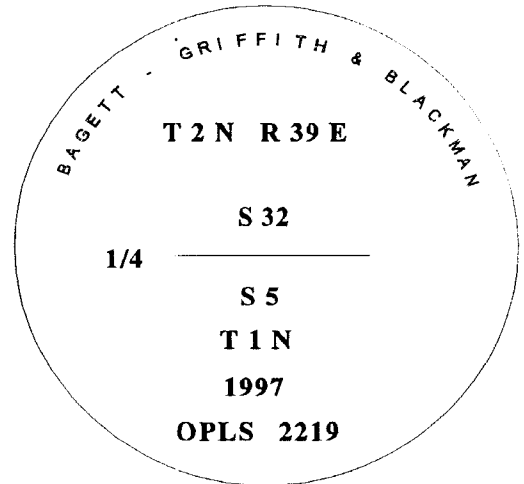
DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2 ½" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 26" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

- A 13" diameter Tamarack bears N 39°E, a distance of 43.93 feet, marked T2N R39E 1/4 S32 BT.
- A 10" diameter Tamarack bears S 74°E, a distance of 12.25 feet, marked T1N R39E 1/4 S5 BT.
- A 19" diameter Douglas Fir bears S 70°W, a distance of 16.22 feet, marked T1N R39E 1/4 S5 BT.
- A 10" diameter White Fir bears N 17°W, a distance of 46.32 feet, marked T2N R39E 1/4 S32 BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 2 feet South of the corner monument. I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on October 13, 1997. Witness: Greg Blackman Jr.

I used magnetic compass and steel tape in the establishment of the accessories to this corner. The distance to the bearing trees is to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the tree at the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the BT blaze.
