TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER: At the position determined by bearing and distance from the bearing tree, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ x 30" Aluminum pipe with cap marked as shown below, 38 inches in the ground. From Which:

A 5/8"x30" Rebar with 1" Aluminum cap Marked Union County Surveyor, NE RP, bears N $38^{\circ}13$ 'E, a distance of 24.70 feet, (at fence corner)

A 5/8"x30" Rebar with 1" aluminum cap Marked Union ounty Surveyor, SE RP, bears S 31°E, a distance of 14.25 feet;

A 40 inch Ponderosa Pine (Graham Survey) bears S 38°13 W, a distance of 75.44 feet, (1.143 ch), blazes evident from Graham

A 5/8"x30" rebar with 1" aluminum cap marked Union County Surveyor, NW RP, bears N 40° W, a distance of 25.10 feet, (sets in East-West Fence).




