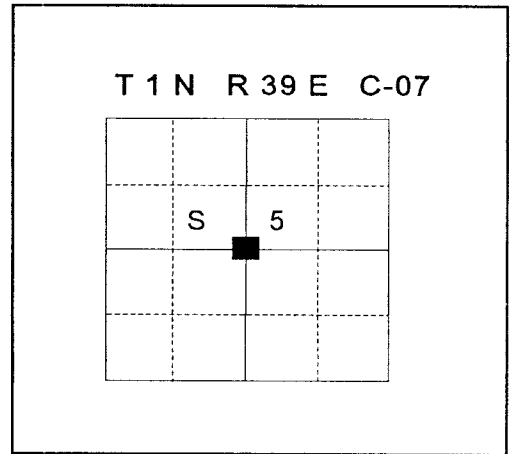


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by said survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 28" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

- A 6" diameter White Fir bears N 34°E, a distance of 3.44 feet, marked C 1/4 S5 BT.
- A 19" diameter Tamarack bears S 63°E, a distance of 23.02 feet, marked X BT.
- An 15" diameter Tamarack bears S 62°W, a distance of 24.17 feet, marked C 1/4 S5 BT.
- A 6" diameter White Fir bears N 81°W, a distance of 7.17 feet, marked X BT.

Set steel fence post approximately 2 feet South of monument.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on October 21, 1997.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. The magnetic declination used was 18° East. The distance to the bearing trees is to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the tree at the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the BT blaze.
