

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 20 inches in the ground, in a mound of stone 2 ft. diam., from which:

A 5/8" x 15" iron pin bears South 42°58' East, a distance of 15.86 feet, with 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked SERP.

A $5/8" \times 15"$ iron pin bears South 61°16' West, a distance of 13.09 feet, with 1 ½" aluminum cap marked SWRP.

I set a steel fence post 1 foot East of the corner monument. Corner falls on the top of a ridge, approximately 120 feet West of the break. Ridgeline runs NW and SE.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on October 5, 2012.
