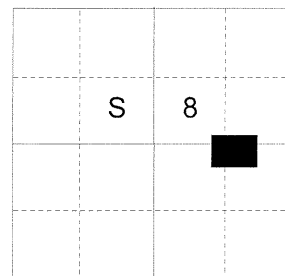

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 26 inches in the ground, in a mound of stone 2 ft. diam., from which:

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South 41°47' West, a distance of 10.25 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked SWRP.


A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 41°27' West, a distance of 8.26 feet, with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked NWRP.

I set a steel fencepost 1 foot North of the corner. Corner falls on the top of a ridgeline, ridge runs NW and SE.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on October 5, 2012.
