
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by Joseph G. Gray and William H. Odell under joint GLO contract number 120, dated May 27, 1867. Surveyor General record states:
Set ¼ section corner. Drove charred stake and raised mound of stone as per instructions.

Oregon State Highway Division calls a position to the corner on strip map number 4B-26-11.

Survey number 17-80 monumented the position called on the strip map with a 5/8" x 30" iron pin with plastic cap marked "BGA SURVEY MARKER"



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found 5/8 inch iron pin with plastic cap marked "BGA SURVEY MARKER" set by survey number 17--80.
