



#### HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by Joseph G. Gray under joint GLO contract with William H. Odell Number 120, dated May 27, 1867. Surveyor General record states: Set 1/4 Section cor. post from which: A Pine 13 in. diam. bears South, 37 lks. A Pine 15 in. diam. bears North, 19 lks.

Old Book Survey No. 228, dated Jan. 25, 1890 subdivides Section 15. Recovers bearing trees, as per GLO survey, but does not mention type of monument at corner position.

Old Book Survey No. 260, dated Sept. 1, 1948 describes finding a stone at the quarter corner position. Survey done by S.B. Morgan in the 1950's, eventually filed as Survey No. 022-1991, describes a stone at quarter corner position also.



Survey 2-74, describes a 1" pin in concrete with the stone laying alongside. Monument is called as such by Plat of Elgin Industrial Park, Surveys 012-2003, 014-2004, 024-2006, 014-2007, 011-2010 and Minor Partitions 20060018T and 20070001T.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:
Found a 1" iron rod in concrete bent severely to the South. The position of the pin as it sits, as determined by Survey 011-2010, is not consistent with other pins in the area. Due to the physical condition of the pin, it is most likely that it has been disturbed. No evidence of the original stone or bearing trees could be found.

From record position, established by ties to pins in the area:

- A 5/8" iron pin bears North  $89^{\circ}53'52$ " West, a distance of 109.57 feet, with plastic cap marked BGA SURVEY MARKER, set as Southwest corner of Lot 8 Plat of Elgin Industrial Park.
- A 5/8" iron pin bears North 16°42'43" West, a distance of 73.00 feet, with plastic cap marked APA, set as the Northwest corner of Parcel 2 Minor Partition No. 20060018T.
- A 5/8" iron pin bears North  $69^{\circ}07'25$ " East, a distance of 191.58 feet, with plastic cap marked APA, set as the Northeast corner of Parcel 2 Minor Partition No. 20060018T.
- A 5/8" iron pin bears South 0°08'21" West, a distance of 8.00 feet, set by Survey Number 2-74, bent pin straightened to position as it enters ground.

#### DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

### TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At record position, I set a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" aluminum pipe with 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked as shown, 27" in the ground, in a collar of stone. Original iron rod in concrete removed. I set a steel fencepost 1 foot North of the corner monument with a bearing tree sign.
