An 18 inch diameter triple bole Ponderosa Pine bears S 67° E, a distance of 30.44 feet, marked 1/4 S33 BT

A 16 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S 62° W, a distance of 52.23 feet, marked 1/4 S33 BT

A 8 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears N 34° W, a distance of 49.85 feet, marked 1/4 S28 BT


