
## **CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

A 5/8" imes 30" rebar with aluminum cap bears S2 $^{f o}$ W, a distance of 22.73 feet, marked "UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR SE RP".

A 5/8" imes 30" rebar with aluminum cap bears S49 $^{
m o}$ W, a distance of 7.40 feet,

marked "UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR SW RP". A  $5/8" \times 30"$  rebar with aluminum cap bears N85 $^{
m o}$ W, a distance of 9.87 feet,

marked "UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR NW RP".
