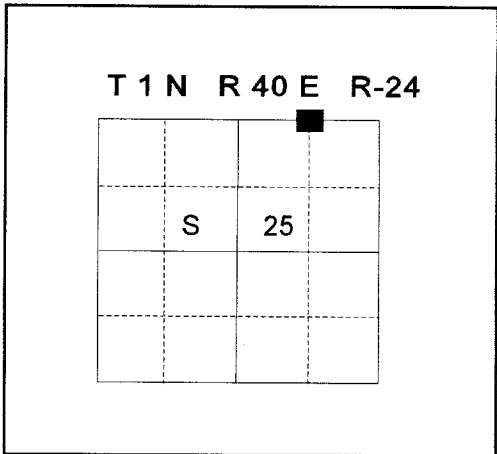

At the position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 25" in the ground, with ring of stone.

**BEARING TREES:**

A 9" Ponderosa Pine bears N 2° W, 9.0 feet, marked E1/16 S24 BT.

A 11" Ponderosa Pine bears S 66° W, 9.1 feet, marked E1/16 S25 BT.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on August 1, 1997.

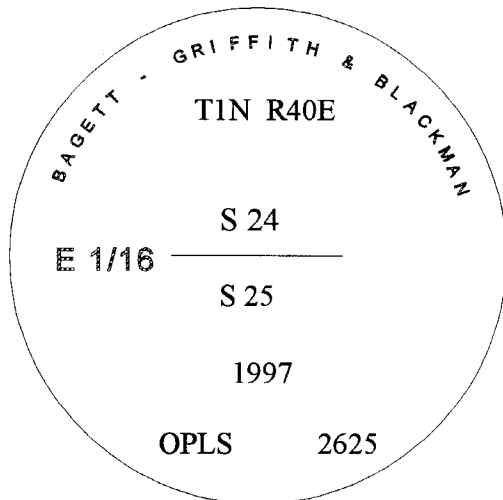
