
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate original location of this corner:

At the position determined by survey, Union County Survey No. 045-2002;

Set a 3 1/4 in. dia. alum. cap on a 5/8 in. dia. by 30 in. long iron rod, buried 17 ins. in the ground, the bottom 8 ins. being in a 5/8 in. dia. drill hole with rod being secured with Rockite cement, with mound of stone and t—post set 1.5 ft. northerly.

A 5/8 in. dia. by 8 in. long iron rod with 1 1/2 in. dia. aluminum cap in a 5/8 in. dia. by 4 in. deep drill hole secured with Rockite cement, set in a rock outcrop 2.5 ft. by 4 ft. by 1 ft. high, mkd: RP NE bears N 87° E, 53.20 ft. dist.

A 5/8 in. dia. by 30 in. long iron rod with 1 1/2 in. dia. aluminum cap at northwesterly corner of rock jack, mkd. : RP SW bears S 42^* W, 41.05 ft. dist.

I hereby certify that the corner was monumented as described and accessories were taken on Oct. 22, 2002, with a hand compass set at 18 $1/2^{\circ}$ E. declination and steel tape.
