
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Corner was never established.




Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate original location of this corner:

At the position determined by survey, Union County Survey No. 045-2002;

Set a 3 1/4 in. dia. alum. cap on a 5/8 in. dia. by 30 in. long iron rod, buried 27 ins. in the ground, with rock collar and t-post set 0.8 ft. northwesterly. Corner is under large rock jack alongside corral.

A 5/8 in. dia. by 30 in. long iron rod with yellow plastic cap mkd: ELDER LS 51277 bears S 26 E, 10.0 ft. dist.
