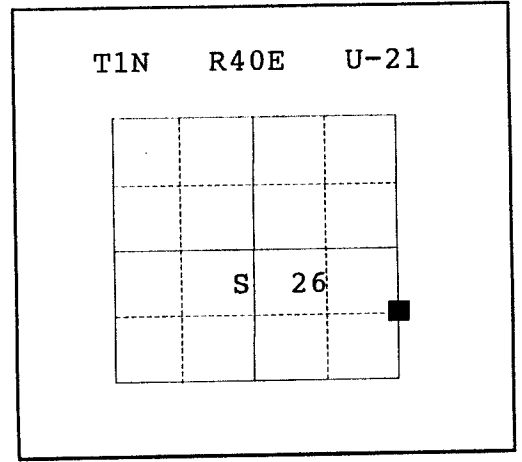

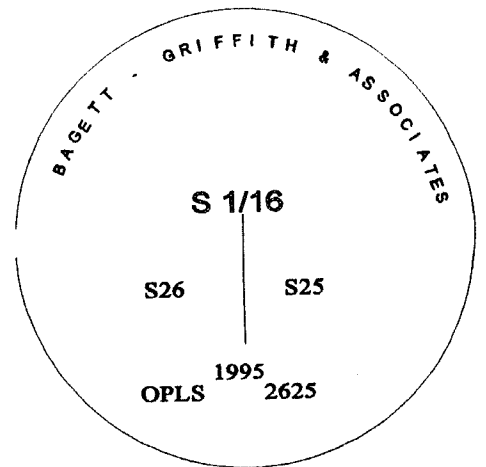
DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

I set a 2½" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground, with a mound of stone 3 feet at the base around the pipe, from which;

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 10" Ponderosa Pine bears N73E, 35.82 feet, marked S 1/16 S25 BT.
a 14" Ponderosa Pine bears S15W, 14.02 feet, marked S 1/16 S26 BT.
