marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER NE RP".
A 5/8" x 30" rebar with aluminum cap bears S72°E, a distance of 6.46 feet, marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SE RP".

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with aluminum cap bears S6°W, a distance of 6.55 feet, marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER SW RP".

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with aluminum cap bears N63°W, a distance of 7.94 feet, marked "BGB SURVEY MARKER NW RP".
