

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by William H. Odell under joint contract with Joseph G. Gray under contract number 120, dated May 27, 1867.

Surveyor's record states: Drove charred stake and raised stone mound.

No record of subsequent monumentation found in UNION COUNTY survey records.

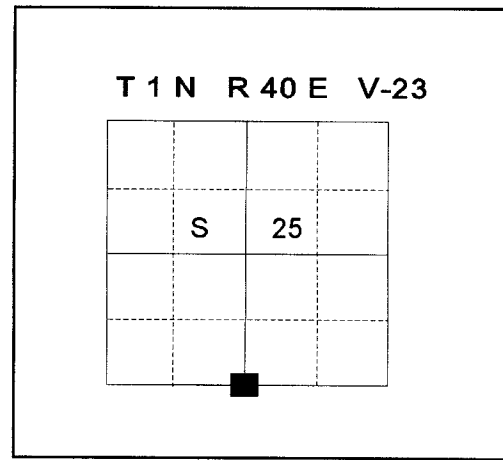
DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with 2 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 30" in the ground, with ring of stone.

BEARING TREES:

- A 19" Ponderosa Pine bears S 81° E, 23.94 feet, marked 1/4 S36X BT.
- A 15" Ponderosa Pine bears S 49° W, 9.86 feet, marked 1/4 S36 BT.
- A 11" Ponderosa Pine bears N 33° W, 51.54 feet, marked 1/4 S25X BT.
- A 16" Ponderosa Pine bears N 16° E, 79.12 feet, marked 1/4 S25 BT.

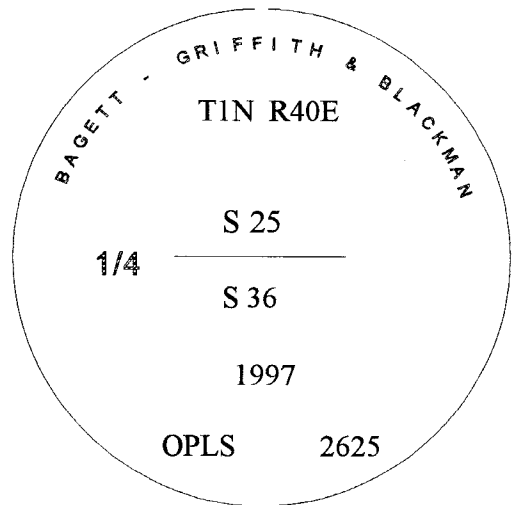
