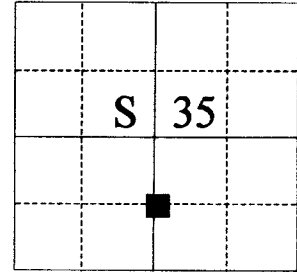

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" rebar with a 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 30" in the ground from which:

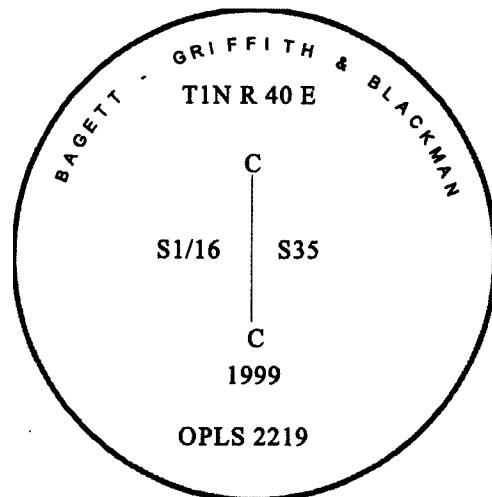

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 18° East declination, the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 2219 to the bearing tree blaze.
